Jurisprudence Exam Information

The PEI College of Pharmacy Jurisprudence Examination is a 2-hour closed book written exam. The pass mark is 70%.

There is a regular spring and a fall sitting each year. Dates and locations are posted on the PEI College of Pharmacists website.

The exam is based on the most up-to-date and relevant provincial and federal legislation and regulations, ethical codes, standards of practice, and practice policies, positions and guidelines that pertain to pharmacy practice as posted on the PEICP website at www.pepharmacists.ca.

Format

The format of the exam is as follows:

- Part A- 20 True or False questions
- Part B- 40 Multiple Choice Questions
- Part C- 10 Matching Questions
- Part D- 5 Identifying missing items in a prescription

Results

Individuals will be notified of their exam results by email. Applicants should allow up to one week for processing of the exam results by the PEICP.
